Business/Hospitality Opportunity

Without a full committee (there are only 4 people on the committee), we are struggling to run the canteen at our competition/training days. As we also have horses and would like to participate in the jumping or dressage events, we are looking for some dedicated help with the canteen. There are a few options: a) we have no canteen and all riders bring their own food and refreshments, b) we get an outside van or mobile company to come and sell their own food and drinks at no cost or profit the club, or c) we offer the canteen position as a business

opportunity to club members, or their friends or relatives. We have decided to offer option c) first and see if anyone comes forward.

This opportunity would involve someone bringing their own food and drinks for sale, working out of the canteen during the day, cleaning up after themselves, giving the club 20% of their proceeds for the day to assist with the venue hiring costs and taking home the rest of the profits. This would suit a retired couple looking to do something for their community or even young people looking for experience in catering or event management. For insurance reasons these people must be over 18 and either be a member of the club, or be a contractor with their own public liability insurance.

We were very privileged to receive his level of knowledge and experience at our training day.

John and his wife Pip now own Falcon Park at Mangrove Mountain and train, ride and breed horses as well as giving dressage, show jumping and cross country instruction to individuals and groups

Show jumping rounds on the day were from 50 cms up to 1.05 cms and it was well attended despite the temperature getting up to 38 degrees. John stood out there all day assisting all those who came and everyone reported to have thoroughly enjoyed his knowledgeable advice.
